

Creating Endnotes in Blog Posts

1. To add endnotes, make sure to be in the “Text” view, rather than the “Visual” view for HTML purposes.

2. Find the location in your post of the first endnote you wish to create. Insert:

```
<a href="http://archives.library.illinois.edu/slc/shortened-title-of-blog-post-used-in-permalink/#note01">[1]</a>
```

Make sure that the text after “slc” and before “#note01” is the correct title!

3. Use the same HTML in all further endnotes and simply change the chronological number.
4. At the end of the blog post, you will create the corresponding citation. Insert:

```
<a id="note01"></a>[1]
```

Follow this HTML with the citation. If you need assistance with correct citations, use the Archives guide to citations available on the website.

5. Use the same HTML in all further citations and simply change the chronological number.
6. Save and check that the HTML works correctly in the preview.
